

Remote Deposit Capture Feature

Many of you have been using the Remote Deposit Capture Feature available on our mobile app. With this feature you can deposit a check into your checking account by simply taking a picture of it using your mobile phone!

It is very important that you print the words **FOR REMOTE DEPOSIT CAPTURE ONLY** on the back of your check. If you do not, your check will not be deposited into your checking account.

Also please remember that it may take up to 24 hours for you to see the deposit in your account and up to 3 days if you make the remote deposit after business hours on a Friday.

If you haven't used this feature but would like to, just start by installing the app on your mobile phone.

Log on to your Home Banking account using a desktop or laptop and click on the button all the way to the right labeled mobiliti, follow the directions to download. You can also download the Touch Banking app from the App Store for free. You will need to enter the following app code: mcpecumobile if using the App Store.

To deposit a check remotely log onto Touch Banking using your phone, click on the deposit option at the bottom of the screen, select new deposit and enter the deposit amount. Allow Touch Banking to access your camera by clicking OK. Take a picture of the front and back of the check following the instructions above the picture capture box.

Carbon Monoxide : The Invisible Killer

Carbon monoxide is an odorless, colorless gas that often goes undetected striking victims caught off guard or in their sleep.

This "silent killer" is produced by burning fuel in cars or trucks, small engines, stoves, lanterns, grills, fireplaces, gas ranges, portable generators or furnaces. When the gas builds up in enclosed spaces, people or animals who breathe it can be poisoned. Ventilation does not guarantee safety.

Winter can be a prime time for carbon monoxide poisoning as people turn on their heating systems and mistakenly warm their cars in garages.

The National Safety Council recommends you install a battery-operated carbon monoxide detector in your home near the bedrooms. Check or replace the battery when you change the time on your clocks each spring and fall.

The CDC offers these additional tips:

- Have your heating system, water heater and any other gas or coal-burning appliances serviced by a qualified technician every year
- Do not use portable flameless chemical heaters indoors
- Never use a generator inside your home, basement or garage or less than 20 feet from any window, door or vent; fatal levels of carbon monoxide can be produced in just minutes
- Have your chimney checked and cleaned every year, and make sure your fireplace damper is open before lighting a fire and well after the fire is extinguished
- Make sure your gas appliances are vented properly
- Never use a gas oven for heating your home
- Never let a car idle in the garage

Know the symptoms of carbon monoxide poisoning

Low to moderate carbon monoxide poisoning is characterized by:

Headache, Fatigue, Shortness of breath, Nausea and/or Dizziness

High level carbon monoxide poisoning results in:

Mental confusion, Vomiting, Loss of muscular coordination,
